

Member Location



MANAGEMENT** The Municipal Service Delivery Officials Board of Directors (MSDO Board) reserves the right to render all interpretations and to establish further or to amend regulations as it may be deemed necessary for the proper conduct and general success of the Conference. - **2. INVOICES** An invoice(s) will be issued by MSDO for sponsorships. Sponsorship payments are to be made via credit card (preferred) or Electronic Fund Transfer and **must be received in full prior to the start of the Conference.**
